

Car Parking

You may have noticed that I was outside school on Monday, monitoring the car parking. This is due to some concerns raised by parents about the dangerous parking and lack of consideration for other road users. This is in addition to the obvious dangers to children crossing the road, vacating cars when being dropped off or younger siblings running into the road.

We have no powers to enforce parking rules in the layby. I have been in touch with Norfolk Police and the District Council and am waiting to hear back from them. In the meantime, if you see anyone who is parked dangerously, we have been advised to make a note of the car registration and this can be reported to SNDC who will follow up on any concerns.

It would, however, be much better if everyone could be more considerate, don't stop your car to drop children off in the middle of the layby—move further down in front of the steps so other cars can get past. Don't park on junctions or leave your car parked across the exit to the layby. Remember at all times that this is a school so there will be children around the layby at the beginning and end of the day.

If everyone was just a little bit more considerate we would not have this problem.
