



## School Uniform

We are very proud of our school and believe that uniform forms an important part of a school's identity. It reinforces who we are as a community and helps allow children to feel pride in their school.

### Children should wear:

- Grey or black trousers or shorts
- Grey or black skirt or pinafore
- White or sky blue polo shirt (with or without the school logo printed on it)
- Royal blue sweat shirt, jumper or fleece (with or without the school logo printed on it)
- White, grey or black socks
- Black shoes (smart trainers are permitted but they should be entirely black with no other colour on them)

### PE Kit:

- Blue or black PE shorts
- Plain white or blue PE t-shirt (with or without the school logo printed on it)
- Trainers
- When it is colder children should have black or blue jogging bottoms or leggings and black or blue sweatshirt/hooded zip jumper.
- All children with long hair should also have a hair band to tie it back.

### Playtime:

- In the winter children are allowed on the school field if they have wellington boots

### Forest Schools:

- If your child's class is taking part in Forest Schools, they will require a complete change of clothes. In the winter they will need waterproofs and wellington boots, gloves, hat etc. We will go outside whatever the weather so they must come prepared.

### Jewellery:

- Children are allowed to wear a wrist watch and stud earrings. No other jewellery should be worn. For PE and swimming earring must be removed.

**Please make sure ALL your child's uniform and belongings are clearly labelled with their name.**
